The Solway Conference Centre

Featuring a state-of-the-art multi-room audio and visual system, each of the four main rooms are fully air-conditioned and fitted with ultra bright high definition data projectors, screens and a multi zone digital sound system. Accommodating up to 500 delegates theatre style or 160 classroom style, this versatile room also has the flexibility to be divided into four separate, fully sound proofed rooms for smaller meetings or concurrent sessions. Solway I-IV range in size and can be combined to create the perfect space for your meeting or event. Solway IV also includes glass bi-fold doors opening onto a 45m² wooden deck with outside furniture.

Lobby and Lower Lounge

The Boardroom

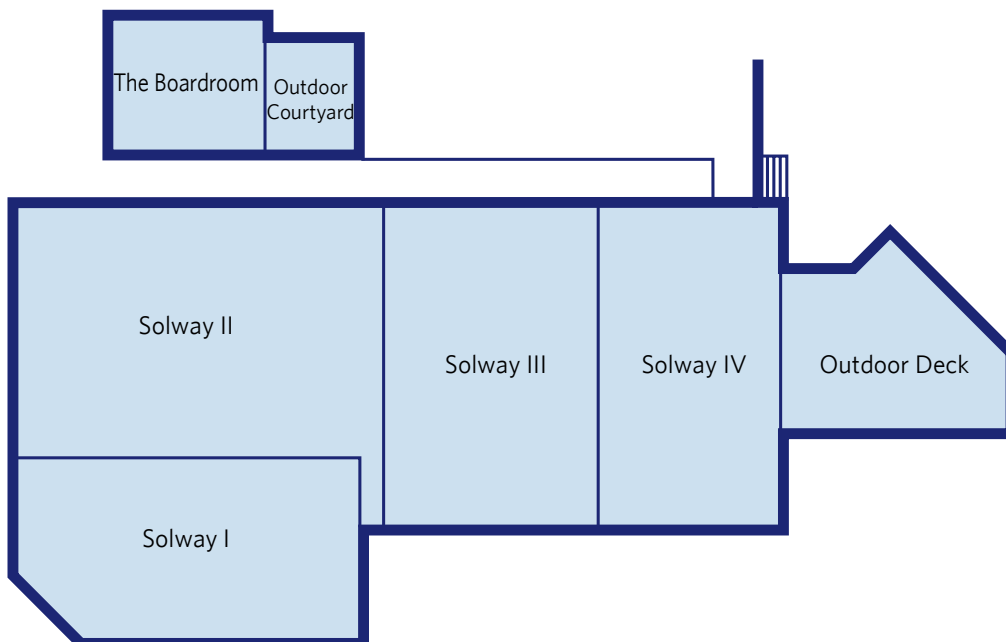

Accommodation

Choose from a range of accommodation with 102 luxury guest rooms including 56 standard rooms, 30 superior rooms, 5 family rooms, 3 executive suites and 8 apartments. Furnished in high country décor, the rooms are complemented with fresh landscape art by local Wairarapa artists.

Standard Room

The standard room comprises one room only with two queen beds, tea and coffee making facilities, fridge, flat screen TV with Sky channels, air conditioning and an ensuite bathroom includes a shower over the bath.

Deluxe Twin Room

The deluxe twin room comprises one room only with two queen sized beds, tea and coffee making facilities, fridge, flat screen TV with Sky channels, air conditioning and an ensuite bathroom with walk-in shower. These rooms have guaranteed carparks outside each room.

Superior Room

The superior room comprises one room only with one king bed, tea and coffee making facilities, fridge, mini bar, flat screen TV with Sky channels, air conditioning and an ensuite bathroom with bath and separate walk-in shower.

Apartment

Popular with families and suited for long stays, each spacious apartment consists of a separate bedroom with one king and one single bed, TV with Sky channels and air conditioning. The separate lounge includes a kitchenette with tea and coffee making facilities, fridge, microwave, dining ware and utensils. This room also has one queen bed, air conditioning and TV with Sky channels. Separate bathroom has a walk-in shower.

Family Room

Ideal for families or couples these spacious two room suites have a king room and twin single room. The master bedroom has a flat screen TV with Sky channels, microwave, tea and coffee making facilities and air conditioning. The back bedroom has a flat screen TV with Sky channels. The toilet and bathroom facilities are separate in between the rooms with a walk-in shower.

Executive Suite

The largest rooms available within the resort. Executive suites offer a separate lounge and dining area ideal for relaxing with friends or holding a private meeting, a tiled patio with outdoor furniture and have either a car park or garden view. Suites contain one separate bedroom with a king bed, robes and slippers and an ensuite bathroom with separate spa bath and shower. Discover Masterton's rich sheep shearing history, visit The Wool Shed, the National Museum of Sheep and Shearing, head to Aratoi, Wairarapa's Museum of Art and History, see native birds at Pukaha Mt Bruce National Wildlife Centre, enjoy the beautiful gardens at Queen Elizabeth Park or head north for a Tui Brewery tour at Mangatainoka.

East of Masterton lies Castlepoint, a surf beach with protected swimming and a choice of walking tracks. Combine the Tararua, Rimutaka and Haurangi Forest Parks with the wild stretch of Palliser Bay and Pacific Ocean coast and you have endless possibilities for outdoor adventures and getting away from it all.

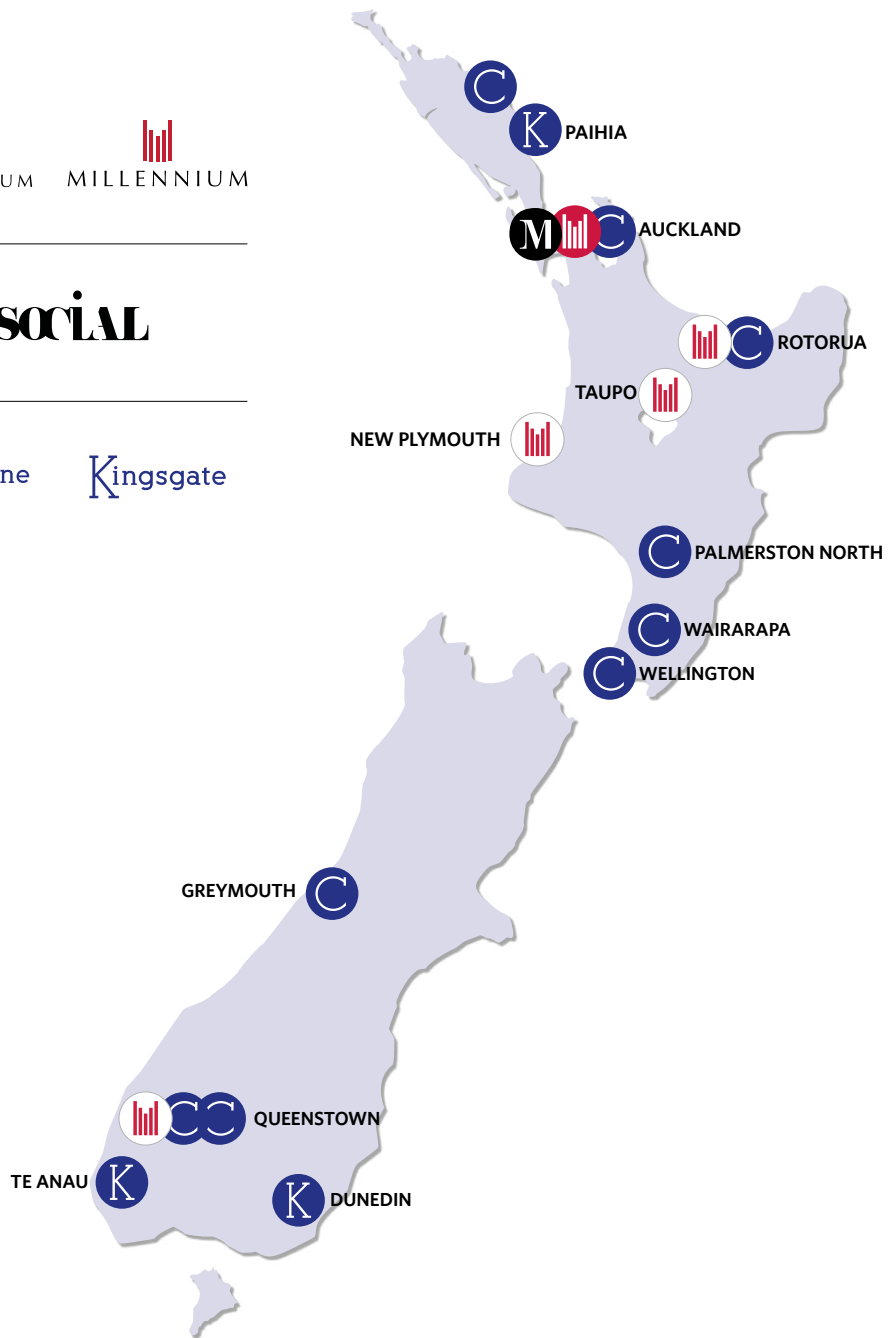
